Take off immediately all contaminated clothing, shoes and leather goods (e.g. watchbands, belts). {Gently blot or brush away excess product.}* Wash with plenty of lukewarm, gently flowing water/....** Immediately call a POISON CENTER/doctor/....* Specific treatment ...*** If breathing has stopped, trained personnel should begin rescue breathing or, if the heart has stopped, immediately start cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) or automated external defibrillation (AED). Avoid mouth-to-mouth contact by using a barrier device. Wash contaminated clothing before reuse {or discard}.
